

Church Service Roles and Responsibilities

- 1. **Bible Study Leader**: Leading or facilitating Bible study groups and discussions.
- 2. **Church Administration**: Assisting with administrative tasks, such as record-keeping, scheduling, and correspondence.
- 3. **Choir Member:** Participating in the church choir or leading the congregation in worship and praise through music.
- 4. **Children's Ministry Volunteer**: Assisting with or leading programs for children, such as Bible classes, crafts, and games.
- 5. **Cleaning Volunteer (Custodial or Maintenance Team)**: Cleaning the church interior and exterior, ensures that the sanctuary and other rooms are clean, tidy, and ready for all church activities.
- 6. **Counseling**: Offering guidance, counseling, and mentorship to members of the congregation.
- 7. **Church Decoration**: Decorating the church for services and special events.
- 8. **Community Service and Charity Work**: Participating in or leading initiatives to serve the broader community.
- 9. **Communications and Social Media**: Managing church communications, websites, and social media presence.
- 10. **Event Planning and Coordination**: Organizing church events, conferences, and retreats.
- 11. Finance Committee Member: Managing church finances, budgeting, and financial reporting.
- 12. **Facility Maintenance**: Helping with the upkeep and maintenance of church buildings and grounds.
- 13. **Greeter**: Welcoming people at the church entrance and helping newcomers feel at ease.
- 14. **Group Admin**: Monitoring online social media against fraud and malicious attacks. Also adding Christians to the group when necessary.
- 15. Hospitality Team: Organizing refreshments and meals for church events and fellowships.
- 16. **Mission Support and Coordination**: Supporting and coordinating mission work and missionaries.
- 17. **Media and Technical Support**: Handling audio-visual equipment, live streaming, and technical aspects of services.
- 18. **Musician**: Playing musical instruments during worship services and other church events.
- 19. **Outreach and Evangelism**: Participating in evangelistic outreach programs, mission trips, and community service.
- 20. **Prayer Team Member**: Leading or participating in prayer sessions, intercessory prayers, and prayer chains.
- 21. **Prayer and Intercession Coordinator**: Organizing and leading prayer meetings and intercessory prayer groups.

- 22. **Pastoral Care**: Visiting and caring for the sick, elderly, and those in need within the church community.
- 23. **Security Team**: Ensuring the safety and security of church members during services and events.
- 24. **Sunday School Teacher**: Teaching children, youth, or adults in Sunday school classes.
- 25. **Transportation Services**: Providing or coordinating transportation for members who need assistance getting to and from church.
- 26. **Ushering**: Welcoming members and visitors, guiding them to their seats, and providing assistance during services.
- 27. **Youth Leader**: Organizing activities, mentoring, and providing spiritual guidance to the youth.
- 28.Others: You can request any other role which has not been listed and our admin will be in touch with you.
